"Teaching Neo-Latin in high schools and on universities. Challenges, ideas, recent developments"

The Committee for Teaching of Neo-Latin of the IANLS invites all members of the IANLS to submit abstracts for a special session to be organized during the next IANLS conference in Aix-en-Provence. The special session shall be dedicated to didactic aspects of Neo-Latin, both in high schools and at the university level. Possible topics for papers in this session include (but are not limited to):

- Presentation of new didactic tools or methods
- Reflection on possible challenges and opportunities when teaching Neo-Latin, both on its own and in interdisciplinary contexts
- Digital humanities as a tool for teaching Neo-Latin
- Case studies of texts that lend themselves especially well for didactic aims

In order to participate at the special session, speakers must be active members of the IANLS (i.e., they are expected to have paid their triennial contribution). Once their proposal has been accepted, they will have to register individually for the conference in Aix.

Please send your abstracts for a paper that fits within the scope of this special session to the chair of the Teaching committee, Christoph Pieper (c.pieper@hum.leidenuniv.nl) no later than April 15th, 2024. The abstract should be between 150 words minimum and 200 words maximum in length. All official languages of the IANLS are acceptable. The Committee will evaluate all submitted abstracts and inform the submitters by April 25th whether their paper can be included into the special session.
